In the legend of the chart display, colour codes of red, amber and green denote actions that are allowed, restricted or completely prohibited. By taking the stress out of knowing exactly what regulations are and where they apply, your teams can focus on the job at hand.

Avoid costly errors

Staying on top of the myriad of rules and regulations in place is a labour-intensive process. Searching through multiple sources of information, determining the relevance of regulations, and planning routes and operations accordingly leaves plenty of room for error. These errors can be costly if they result in vessels being found in violation of environmental regulations.


At sea, even the most experienced mariner can misunderstand a baseline or overlook the fact that the ship is entering a restricted zone.

Accurate baselines






Colour-coded actions

Quickly assess what actions are allowed, restricted or prohibited at any given coordinate with green, amber and red colour-coded tiles.




Access environmental regulations
